1. Declared Dance students MUST receive advising through the Visual & Performing Arts (V&PA) Department (954-201-6843; Dance@broward.edu) at the beginning of their studies.
2. Financial Aid covers the first 24 elective credits under the Associates of Arts Degree. All Dance courses fall under the electives category.
3. Dance Appreciation (DAN2100) counts as a Humanities credit and as a writing credit course.
4. Dance Repertory is a restricted class consisting of performance in a Dance Concert. Students must audition for admittance to this class. For information on audition notices please visit Broward.edu.
5. MGF1106 and MGF1107 are general education math courses that do not require prerequisites. MAC1105C is a 5-credit course. Students who register for this course must see an advisor to discuss their academic plan.
6. Pointe I (DAA2220) is an elective course and is only offered to second year students. Departmental approval is required for registration.
7. Students must take ENC1101, ENC1102, and two additional writing credit courses (6 credits) to graduate.
8. One science lab course is required. The student may choose to take either the Physical or Biological Science lab.
9. Beginning Fall 2019, first-time in college students must demonstrate competency in civic literacy either through passing POS2041/AMH2020 or CLEP/AP.
10. Students must successfully meet the foreign language requirement as prescribed in the college's policies and procedures 6Hx2-4.22.
11. The computer literacy requirement must be met by taking either CGS1060C or testing out.
12. Students must take 3 credits of International/Intercultural coursework to graduate.
