1. The National Association of Schools of Theatre ([NAST](#)) accredits Broward College. Declared Theatre students MUST receive advising in the Theatre Department by contacting Theatre@broward.edu at the beginning of their studies.
2. Financial Aid covers the first 24 elective credits under the Associate of Arts Degree. All Theatre courses fall under the electives category. Theatre Appreciation counts as a Humanities credit.
3. Students must take ENC1101; ENC1102 or ENC2210; and two additional writing credit courses (6 credits) to graduate.
4. The computer literacy requirement is an elective that must be met by taking either CGS1060C or testing out.
5. One science lab course is required. The student may choose to take either a Physical or Biological Science lab.
6. Performance I, II, and III are restricted classes consisting of performance in a Theatre production. Students must audition for admittance to these classes. For information on audition notices please visit [Broward.edu](#).
7. Students must successfully meet the foreign language requirement as prescribed in the college's policies and procedures 6Hx2-4.22. Students should confirm with an academic advisor if they have fulfilled the foreign language requirement.
8. Students must take 3 credits of International/Intercultural coursework to graduate.
9. Beginning Fall 2019, first-time in college students must demonstrate competency in civic literacy either through passing AMH2020 or CLEP/AP.
10. MGF1106 and MGF1107 are general education math courses that do not require prerequisites. MAC1105C is a 5-credit course. Students who register for this course must see an advisor to discuss their academic plan.
